

### **Comments to tables 1.3**

Quarterly and yearly data have been corrected by the SCS and may not correspond to the sum of monthly figures.

Industrial production (both nominal and real) shown in the first two columns covers approximately 9 800 medium and large Ukrainian enterprises (see Table 8.3). The SCS publishes the %-change of industrial production in current month over previous month, which allows constructing chain index. Index of real industrial production (column 2) is built with a combination of chain index and the index of real production of the previous month. Please note that monthly data are very preliminary and subject to further revision.

The UEPLAC has computed an alternative monthly index of industrial production based on production data in physical terms for 249 main industrial products. These products are aggregated on the basis of dollar prices and lead to a 1990-based Laspeyres index (see supplement to *Ukrainian Economic Trends*, April 1995). This index is given in column 4. New series with seasonal adjustment have been built by the UEPLAC both for UEPLAC's index and for the recalculated official index: they appear in columns 3 and 5. Column 6 (of tables 1.3 A and 1.3 Q) shows the value added of industry in nominal terms as it appears in the SNA.
