

Comments to tables 3.4 A and 3.4 Q

The index of apparent average productivity is drawn from industrial production in Table 1.3 and total employment in industry in column 1 (*Number of personnel*) of these tables.

The difference between number of days actually worked on average by each employee in industry and the total number of working days (so called *under-employment*) could be observed through columns 3 to 5. Column 6 (*Corrected number of full-employed*) is the result of multiplying of column 1 by the ratio of column 3 to column 5.
